## OUT OF THE ORDINARY

Onetime art director and online designer Leah Giberson now creates art of a more tangible sort. She hunts for photographs of suburban scenes—homes, cars, pools— and mounts them on wood panels; then she enhances these images with layers of acrylic paint.
